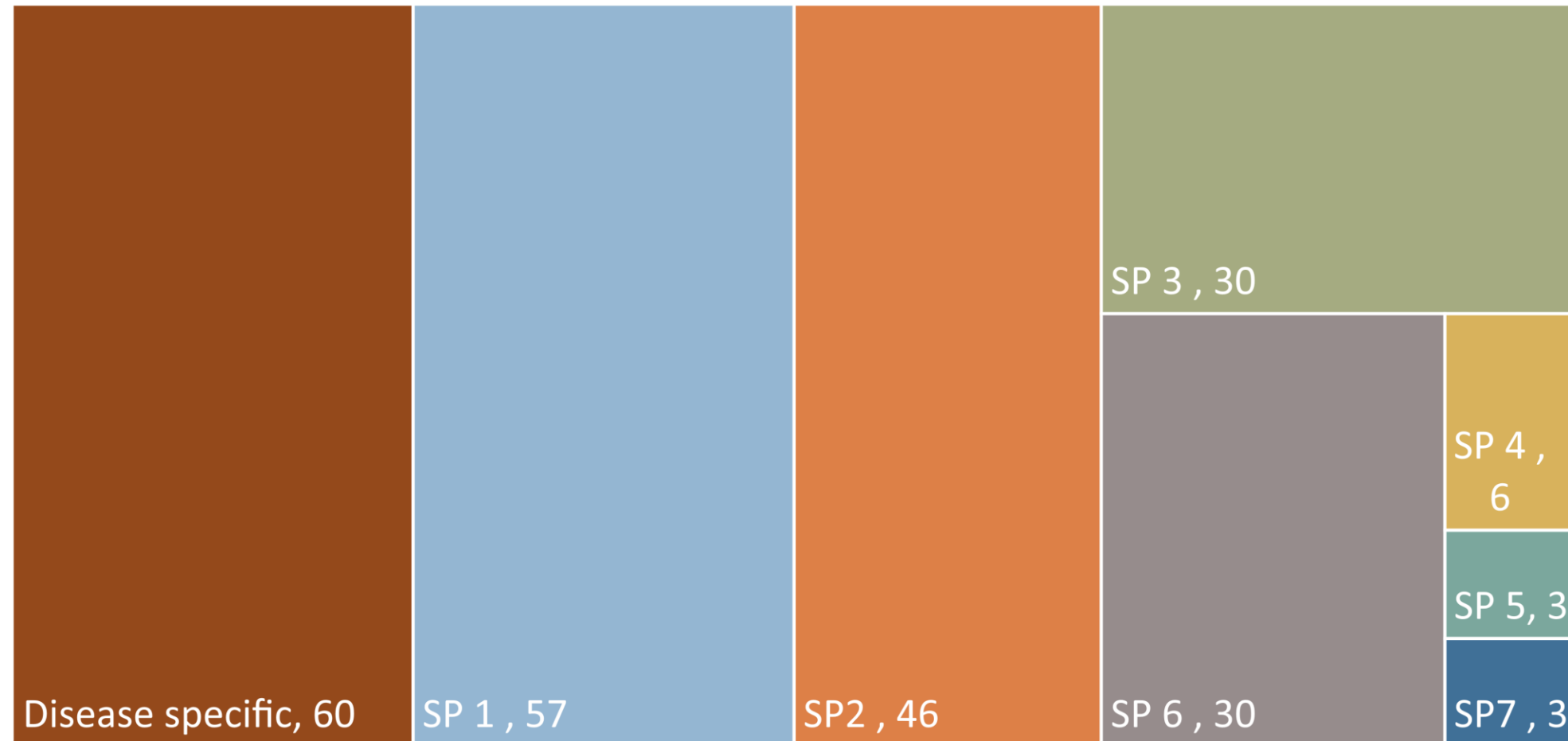

with the WHO European Regional Office

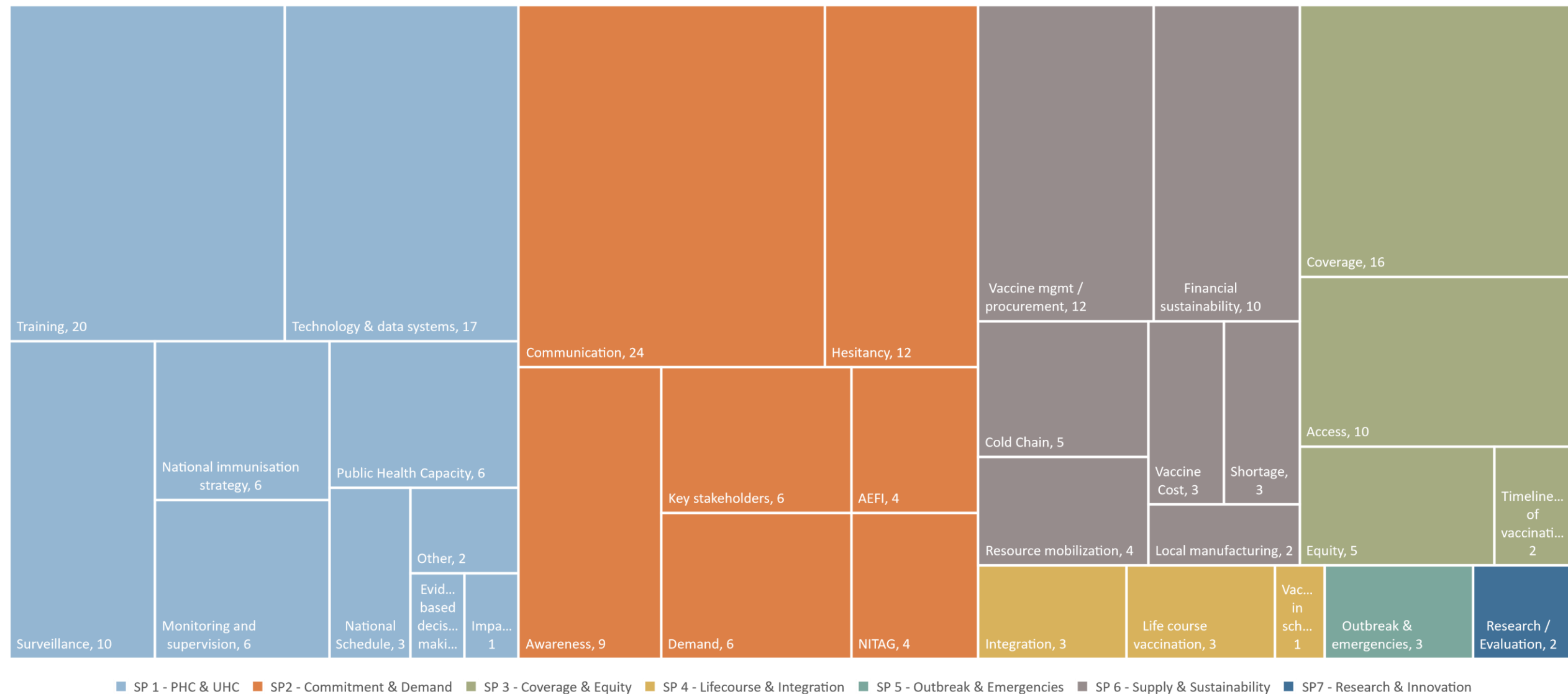
Analysis of national priorities according to the Global IA2030 strategic priorities

How the “regional focus areas” will be determined for EIA 2030



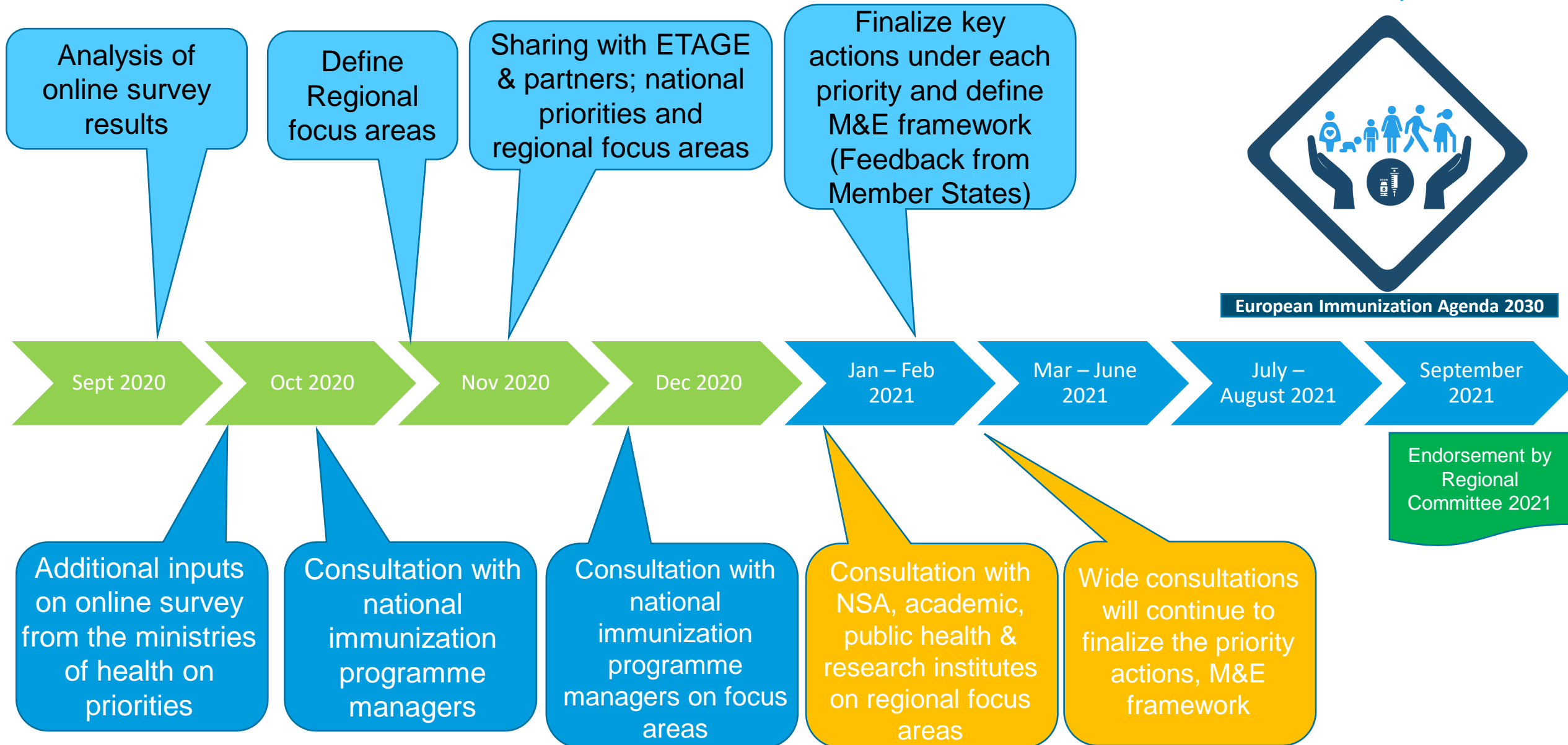

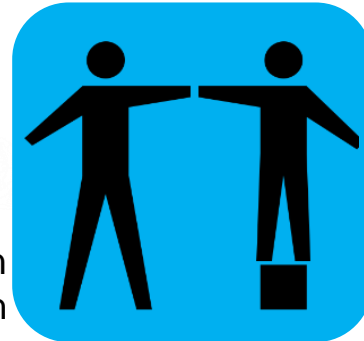
- **engage local governments** in political commitment, institutional change, capacity-building, partnership-based planning and innovation

- **strongly emphasizes equity, participatory governance and solidarity, intersectoral collaboration** and action to address the determinants of health.



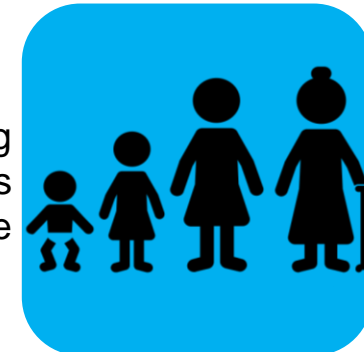
